## **Supporting the 2025 Festival for the Province of East Kent**

### **Our history**

Charity has always been a core principle of Freemasonry, and over the last 300 years Freemasons have established a number of charities – including schools, care homes and a hospital.

The Masonic Charitable Foundation (MCF) was created in 2016 and brought together the work of four separate charities:

The Freemasons' Grand Charity

The Royal Masonic Trust for Girls and Boys

The Masonic Samaritan Fund

The Royal Masonic Benevolent Institution

The legacy of these charities and the principle of charity can be seen today through the work of the MCF.

Since MCF was created in April 2016, Freemasons and their families in East Kent have received 1,222 grants to the value of nearly £3million (it is in fact £2,987,911), to support children, young people with their education, families with daily living costs and those needing support with their health, care and wellbeing.

In addition, 89 charities in East Kent have been supported with grants totalling over £850k (actual figure is £855,769). Charities including, most recently in 2022 / 2023:

- Involve Kent (Links).
- 21 Together.
- The Young Lives Foundation.
- We Are Beams.
